

Report Title: ACS Reports Currently Overdue

Report Purpose: Provides ACS workers with a list of CPS reports that are currently overdue. Reports are identified as overdue if the difference between the Intake Start Date and the date of the latest refresh of the Data Warehouse is more than 60 days

Corresponds to the measure "CPS Reports Currently Overdue" that is available in the pre-defined PowerPlay report CPS Stages and Reports Current Status.

These results should also be consistent with Overdue Reports information from the OCI with two exceptions:

- (1) The actual run date of the OCI is several days after the end of each month.
- (2) The OCI does not count investigation conclusions as overdue if they have been rejected by a supervisor.

This report uses the Investigations Catalog. Users can customize this report and save a copy locally for future use.
