

## Tracked Child Contacts Summary

**Report Background** The Tracked Child Contacts Summary report can help Voluntary Agency supervisors and managers by providing an overview of tracked children with and without contacts from their agency staff. This report is part of the “Casework Contact Reports” series.

**Report Purpose** There are two sections of this report – one focusing on the number of tracked children contacted and the other focusing on the number of contacts attempted or made:

**Tracked Children:** Provides Voluntary Agencies with the number and percentage of tracked children that have successful face-to-face contacts recorded in CONNECTIONS from agency staff during a specified month, as well as the number and percentage of children that have no contacts or attempted contacts by agency staff.

**Contacts:** Provides Voluntary Agencies with the number of “Contacts” and “Attempted Contacts” with tracked children recorded in CONNECTIONS from agency staff during a specified month, as well as the number and percentage of those that were successful face-to-face contacts.

**Target Users** Managers and supervisors from Voluntary Agencies.

**Classification** Management report

**Prompts** Upon opening the report, users are asked to select one or more values from a list of choices for the following report prompts:

- District/Agency: Select the name of the Voluntary Agency for which you want to run the report. Agencies are listed alphabetically by agency code.
- Stage type(s): Select the Stage types (CCR, CWS) that you want to include in the report.
- Month/Year: Select the month and year for which you want to view data.

**Notes** **Please be patient – these reports may take several minutes to run.** Data is available for completed months only, starting with January 2007. Individual columns in the report should not be added together – they are not meant to sum to the “Total” number. Instances where the number of tracked children in this report does not match the number at the top of the “Tracked Child Contacts” report are the result of children with multiple PIDs.

Data Item	Data Definition
LDSS/Agency Name	The name and 3-digit agency code for the Voluntary Agency selected at the report prompt. This report can be run for only one agency at a time. Since this report provides only aggregate data, Voluntary Agency staff can run this report for any other Voluntary Agency for comparative purposes.

Data Item	Data Definition
<b>Site Code/Unit Number</b>	There is no Unit prompt for this report; it runs for the entire Agency.
<b>Stage Type</b>	The Stage types selected at the report prompt. By definition, a tracked child is linked to a Stage type of CWS (Child Welfare Services) or CCR (Child Case Record). The user may select one or both Stage types for inclusion in the report.
<b>Report Period</b>	The month and year selected at the report prompt. Only Progress Notes with a Contact Date during the month are included in the report.
<b>Report Date</b>	The date on which the report was run.
<b>Data as of Date</b>	The latest refresh date of the OCFS Data Warehouse – that is, the last time data was retrieved from CONNECTIONS. This will indicate when the monthly data was last updated.
<b>Total – Open Family Service Stages</b>	The number of open Family Services Stages in CONNECTIONS during the Report Period for the Stage Types and Agency selected at the prompt.
<i>(Column)</i> <b>Total</b>	The total number of tracked children in CONNECTIONS during the Report Period. A tracked child is defined as a child in a Family Services Stage (FSS) with a Type of CWS or CCR <i>and</i> who has an active Program Choice and PPG. If a child was part of more than one open Stage during the month, the child is counted more than once.
<i>(Column)</i> <b>With 2 or More Successful Face-to-Face Contacts</b>	<p>The number of tracked children with at least two Progress Notes as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Type: <a href="#">Casework Contact</a></li> <li>• Method: <a href="#">Face to Face</a></li> <li>• Participant: <a href="#">Tracked child's name</a></li> <li>• Focus: <a href="#">Tracked child's name</a></li> </ul> <p>The percentage uses the “Total” column as the denominator. This column is a subset of the “With At Least One Successful Face-to-Face Contact” column.</p>
<i>(Column)</i> <b>With At Least One Successful Face-to-Face Contact</b>	<p>The number of tracked children with at least one Progress Note as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Type: <a href="#">Casework Contact</a></li> <li>• Method: <a href="#">Face to Face</a></li> <li>• Participant: <a href="#">Tracked child's name</a></li> <li>• Focus: <a href="#">Tracked child's name</a></li> </ul> <p>The percentage uses the “Total” column as the denominator.</p>
<i>(Column)</i> <b>With No Successful or Attempted Contacts Recorded</b>	<p>The number of tracked children with no “Casework Contact” or “Attempted Casework Contact” Progress Notes where the child is a participant or focus – regardless of contact method.</p> <p>The percentage uses the “Total” column as the denominator.</p>

<p>(Column)</p> <p><b>Total Successful or Attempted</b></p>	<p>The number of contacts with the following Progress Note specification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Type: <a href="#">Casework Contact or Attempted Casework Contact</a></li> <li>Participant: <a href="#">Tracked child's name</a></li> <li>Focus: <a href="#">Tracked child's name</a></li> </ul> <p>All contact methods are included in this count.</p>
<p>(Column)</p> <p><b>Total Successful Face-to-Face</b></p>	<p>The number of contacts with the following Progress Note specification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Type: <a href="#">Casework Contact</a></li> <li>Method: <a href="#">Face to Face</a></li> <li>Participant: <a href="#">Tracked child's name</a></li> <li>Focus: <a href="#">Tracked child's name</a></li> </ul> <p>The percentage uses the "Total Successful or Attempted" column as the denominator.</p>
<p>(Row)</p> <p><b>Tracked Children</b></p>	<p>A count of Person ID-Stage ID combinations during the Report Period. A "tracked child" is defined as a child in a Family Services Stage (FSS) with a Type of CWS or CCR <i>and</i> who has an active Program Choice and PPG. If a child was part of more than one open Stage during the month, the child is counted more than once.</p> <p>Tracked Children = Foster Care + Non-Foster Care</p>
<p>(Row)</p> <p><b>Foster Care</b></p>	<p>A count of the Person ID-Stage ID combinations for tracked children with a Program Choice of "Placement" (code C) in CONNECTIONS at the end of the Report Period or the end of the Stage, whichever came first.</p> <p>Tracked Children = Foster Care + Non-Foster Care</p>
<p>(Row)</p> <p><b>Non-Foster Care</b></p>	<p>A count of the Person ID-Stage ID combinations for tracked children that do not have a Program Choice of "Placement" in CONNECTIONS at the end of the Report Period or the end of the Stage, whichever came first.</p> <p>Tracked Children = Foster Care + Non-Foster Care</p>
<p>(Row; FC PPG)</p> <p><b>Return to Parent / Discharge Resource</b></p>	<p>A count of the Person ID-Stage ID combinations for tracked children with the following entries in CONNECTIONS at the end of the Report Period or the end of the Stage, whichever came first:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Program Choice: <a href="#">Placement</a></li> <li>PPG description: <a href="#">Return to Parent</a></li> <li>PPG code/subcode: <a href="#">1A or 1B</a></li> </ul>
