

Report Title: **Foster Children Grouped by In Care and IV-E Status**

Report Purpose: Provides the overall number of foster children in four categories: (1) in care & IV-E, (2) in care & not IV-E, (3) absent & IV-E, and (4) absent & not IV-E. Users must enter a month and region at the report prompt. There is also a drill-thru to a child detail report, when the user double-clicks on a District name.

Report Prompt: Users must select their region. Statewide and Regional Office staff will be able to view data for children in all counties for the regions selected, while Districts will be able to view data only for children in their county.

Drill-thru Report: After the report runs, click on the County name hyperlink to display detailed information on the children in care at the end of the month selected at prompt.

Package: This report uses the OCFS DW – Child Welfare Services package.
