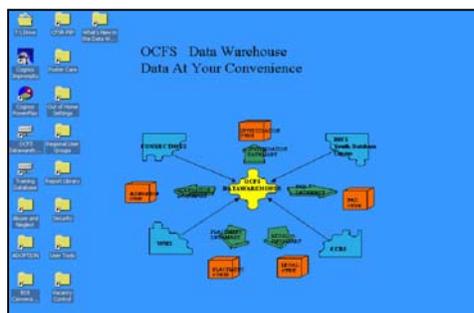
## Data Warehouse Environments

## SSL VPN Access

SSL VPN agencies can now request access to the Cognos ReportNet environment and predefined FASP reports. Download the **SSL VPN Instructions for Access to Cognos ReportNet** pdf and the OCFS-4827 request form from the Data Warehouse page of the CONNECTIONS Intranet site, and follow the instructions. Once the request is submitted and access has been granted, staff with Cognos ReportNet access will have a link to ReportNet on their SSL VPN portal page.

## 2005 CFSR PIP Data

The **Six National Indicators** report is now available for FFY 2005. The report contains data for 6 safety and permanency indicators based on the CFSR federal guidelines – Maltreatment in Foster Care, Recurrence of Maltreatment, Re-entry to Foster Care, Discharge to Adoption, Reunification with Parent/Caretaker, and Stability of Placement. The report is located in the CFSR PIP folder of the PowerPlay/Impromptu environment. Read the accompanying report write-up to see how the indicators are defined.

These trainings will focus solely on the Cognos PowerPlay/Impromptu environment, including CPS allegations and investigations, CCRS placements, and foster care facility reports and data. *These trainings will not include the Data Warehouse Case Management FASP Reports.*

## New FASP Reports Coming Soon

The **FASP Activities Series** is a new set of Cognos ReportNet reports that has been released. There are four main reports – Overdue FASP Activities, Due FASP Activities, Current Pending FASP Activities, and Approved FASP Activities – that focus on the FASP submittal-approval process. Based on the parameters selected at the report

prompts, the reports display a list of FASPs with the number of times each FASP has been submitted, rejected, and approved. Users can also “drill thru” any FASP in the main reports to see the FASP Activity Details report, which displays the submittal-approval history for that FASP. An announcement will be made when the reports are released.
