

Facility Status Change History with Closure Reason Code

Report Purpose	Provides a detailed list of when the status of a facility changed.
Prompts	Upon opening the report, users are asked to complete the following report prompt: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>District/Agency</u>: Enter a district/agency code; this prompt is case sensitive.
Notes	This report uses the vacancy control package, so the data is refreshed daily. The status changes go as far back as 9/22/2003.

Data Item	Data Definition
Report Date	The date on which the report was run.
Data As Of Date	The latest refresh date of the OCFS Data Warehouse – that is, the last time data was retrieved from CONNECTIONS. Data for this report is refreshed each week.
Agency	The 3-digit code and name of the agency that owns the resource.
Facility Count	A distinct count of the Resource IDs that have had a status change for the agency selected at the prompt.
Resource ID	The CONNECTIONS identification number for the facility.
Facility ID	The CONNECTIONS vendor identification number for this resource.
Level of Care	The level of care provided by the resource.
Facility Status	The current status of the facility. Values include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accepted-Active • Accepted-Inactive • Applicant • Closed • Closed-Duplicate • Emergency • Inquiry • Pending Closure • Pending Acceptance • Pending Emergency
Status Change	An indicator as to whether the status of the home was changed. The field is filled with an * only if the status of the facility changed.
Status Change Date	The date on which the status became effective.

Data Item	Data Definition
Closure Reason	The three digit code corresponding to the closure reason.
Closure Reason Text	<p>The reason the facility was closed.
