ODS Definition

The CONNECTIONS Operational Data Store is the primary source for sharing detailed CONNECTIONS data with local districts and voluntary agencies. The ODS contains a daily snapshot of CONNECTIONS data. This data is secured at the LDSS / VA level and, once initialized, provided incrementally (“drawn down”) on a regular basis. Districts and agencies may use this data for local reports or other functional purposes.

In this session we will further define the CONNECTIONS ODS and describe the responsibilities and requirements of participating organizations.
