**Re:** Invalid Program Type Clean Up Report

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Attached is the third and final Build 15 Foster and Adoptive Home clean up report. This report identifies Resources that have been entered into CONNECTIONS with an invalid Program Type.

Build 15, scheduled for release the weekend of May 18, 2002, includes system edits that require that a valid correlation exist between Setting (foster home, adoptive home, or congregate care) and Program Type. After implementation of Build 15, if an invalid Program Type is selected by the user, a system status message will be displayed indicating that an invalid Program Type has been selected for the Setting. The clean up report identifies Resources that do not comply with these edits.

Please review the report and correct the Program Type on the CONNECTIONS FA Home License window by COB May 15, 2002. Any Resources with invalid program types not corrected prior to Build 15 will be converted to a "Regular" Program Type in conjunction with Build 15 implementation. Below, to assist you in this clean up is a chart of valid Program Types/Statuses for Foster and Adoptive Home Settings.

The clean up report is a Microsoft Excel spreadsheet. The spreadsheet has the following columns: Agency ID, Primary Worker, Resource ID, Resource Name, Home Status, Home Setting, Invalid Program Types. To access information for your district/agency, click on the pull down arrow on the Agency ID field in the upper left corner of the spreadsheet and select your district/agency ID. The resulting list will display only those Resources that belong to your district/agency sorted by Resource ID number. The report can be sorted using the Sort options on the Data Menu. If you print the report, we recommend you print in landscape view.
