**Re:** Changes to the CPRS following Build 16

---

**The purpose of this communication is to clarify the Build 16 changes that were made to all Open CPS Investigations as of 12/12/03.**

**The following is a list of these changes. We are in the process of developing some additional resource materials, which should be available to the field in early January 2004.**

- Print All has been re-named “Generate Report” and displays a print dialog that allows the user to select one tab, a series of tabs or all\* tabs to generate a report. \*The ability to Print All tabs is limited to Pre-Build 16 Investigations.
- Display duplicate investigation Stage ID on the Investigative Findings Tab when appropriate.
- Display WMS case number entered on the Investigation Conclusion Window on the background of the CPRS.
- Existing and new fields from the Investigation Conclusion window will be displayed on the Investigative Findings Tab.
- Support a push button to view the Intake Narrative from the CPRS background.
- Display “Fatality Report” in background of CPRS, if appropriate.
- Display Stage CD on the background of CPRS, for NYC cases.

- Allegation Tab- Push button added to access reporter/source information with appropriate security.
- Case ID Grid- Add event status for Investigation Conclusion event.
- Household Member Detail Grid- Field display improved; Ethnicity / Race added and “multiple” displayed if more than one Race is selected.
- N Tier Architecture
- Correct page numbering in CPRS print out.
