Also the field identifying the Secondary Caretaker is missing.	This fix will display the information on the Secondary Caretaker in the FASP component report and the Final FASP report under SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION section. Field identifying the Secondary Caseworker will be added.	2776
All	Final FASP Report	Below the heading for Family Scales in the Component and the Full FASP reports there is a field for Primary Caretaker and Secondary Caretaker. When a Secondary Caretaker is selected, the name of the Secondary Caretaker does not display. Comments section appeared for a household in the Full FASP report when no comments were entered.	This fix will display the name of the Secondary Caretaker in the correct field and will not display the Comments section on the Secondary household when it is blank.	2783
All	Common	The parent is a minor, identified as the primary caretaker and as a "parent" in the relationship matrix, however is still displayed in the Strengths Needs and Risks Child scales.	This fix will display the minor parent in the Parent/Caretaker Strengths Needs and Risk scales only.	2803
Intake workers	FSI	In the FSI Narrative tab after text has been entered and saved the spell check remains enabled and picks up words from the locked narrative.	The fix will only allow the new text entered to be spell checked.	2813
Case Manager/ Intake Worker	FSI, FSS	There is a mismatch in the ethnicity codes between the FSI and the FSS. When "Multiple" is selected in the FSI it does not carry the ethnicity forward to the FSS.	This change will eliminate multiple as a selection in the FSI drop down.	2859
Case Planner/ Supervisor	FASP	An incomplete RAP causes an error when a Supervisor attempts to approve the FASP even though the RAP is not required.	If RAP completion is not required for the FASP the case will move through the approval process as usual.	2920

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All	Assign Window	When a block assign is done the program does not check to see if the person being assigned to the multiple stages is already assigned to one (or more) of the stages. Using a block assign a person can be assigned as the primary and the secondary on a stage.	The fix is that the Block Assign will not be allowed if the "To be assigned to" worker already has a role in any of the stages. An appropriate warning message will be displayed in this case..	2921

Case Manager/ Data Entry Operator	Legacy/ Interfaces	When the interface component APP/REG is invoked for a new case a registration number and a version number is returned to the user for the user to note. When the user clicks the OK button on the message box, the registration number and version number is written to the Stage table. When the OK button has not been pressed and Citrix timed out neither the registration number nor the version number is written to the Stage table, subsequent updates fail because no match is found.	The change will move the message to display after the registration number and the version number are written to the Stage table.	2962
