***CONNECTIONS Build 18.7.4 Implementation ...***

***Friday, May 19, 2006***

CONNECTIONS Build 18.7.4 will be implemented on Friday, May 19<sup>th</sup>. The content of the Build is detailed in the Build 18.7.4 Release Notes that were communicated on Monday, May 15<sup>th</sup> and posted to the intranet website on the Implementation page. The Build features user requested enhancements, as well as modifications and fixes to application functionality including, the FSS Case Summary, Progress Notes, Intake, FSI and printing. During the implementation of the Build the CONNECTIONS application will be unavailable (for approximately 6 hours) from 6:00 PM Friday evening through midnight (Saturday, May 20<sup>th</sup>).

***CONNECTIONS Upstate Build 18 Case Management Quick Reference ...***

A bit of history about how this document came to be...the CONNECTIONS Upstate Build 18 Case Management Quick Reference was designed as a navigational tool to assist users with common CONNECTIONS functionality. The document includes topics such as Entering Progress Notes, Case Manager Reassignments and Approving an FSS Closure, as well as, FAQ's related to the FASP. This document is not intended to *replace* any of the support tools that are currently being used by the field however, the intent of this quick reference is to *enhance and supplement* current tools that are in use. Regional Implementation staff saw a user need and, as such, this document was "born". The upstate version of the quick reference is available on the CONNECTIONS Intranet website on the Job Aids page. And...we are proud to report that this is the first of series of documents developed for this purpose! Stay tuned for more navigational tools (documents) in the weeks to come!

*\*\*Please note that this reference document was developed for use upstate as the New York City region has had a version of this reference document in use for a period of time prior to the development of the upstate version.*

### ***Records Retention Info...***

On Thursday, May 18<sup>th</sup>, a communication was forwarded to local district Directors of Services and local district CONNECTIONS Implementation Coordinators. The content of that communication is detailed as follows:

“As you are aware, the CONNECTIONS quarterly Records Retention run purges all records that meet the statutory timeframes for expungement, and produces a report of all records "to be expunged" in the next quarterly run. The purpose of the prospective report is to provide Records Retention contacts in each local district with the opportunity to review records in advance of expungement, and either confirm the upcoming expungement and prepare the corresponding paper records for manual destruction or, correct on-line data as necessary if the expungement designation is incorrect. In preparation for the running of the the next Records Retention batch, we have attached a spreadsheet listing those individuals that districts have previously identified as Records Retention Report designees or recipients. We ask that you review the attached spreadsheet to make certain that we have the correct individuals listed and ask that you respond ***only if a correction or change is necessary.*** In the event that a change to the designee is necessary, please use the attached Management Report Update form and provide the name and CONNECTIONS PID of the report recipient (designee). It should be noted that designees must have access to CONNECTIONS to receive these reports. Please return your completed forms by ***Wednesday, May 24, 2006***, to either Donna Cramer or Marie Wiley.”
