***The Direction of CONNECTIONS...***

As we identified in the Weekly last week, the scheduled implementation date for Build 18.9 is Friday, March 23, 2007. We are currently conducting User Acceptance Testing for this Build and will be issuing the Build Highlights document at the end of January 2007. We have also developed tools to assist in the implementation of the Build, and, as such, recently introduced the Impact Analysis for Build 18.9 Security as well as Questions and Answers from the Build 18.9 Forums. We will soon be releasing an updated version of the Business Process Redesign Manual, which includes information regarding the functionality that is currently included in Build 18.9.

We are moving in the direction of sculpting the contents of future Builds and will be meeting with line staff from both local districts and voluntary agencies during the first quarter of 2007 to listen to their issues related to the way that the application currently operates. We look forward to the chance to meet with you and will keep you current about any future system modifications!

***Build 18.9 Tools ~ The Impact Analysis for Build 18.9 Security...***

In preparation for the Build implementation, we have drafted an Impact Analysis related to the security that will be necessary to compliment the functionality of the Build.
