### CONNECTIONS Build:

#### Intake Checklist, Foster Care Notification, and Foster Home Identification

#### Phase 2 Tentatively Scheduled for Early December

The next build to the CONNECTIONS application includes several new windows to support the identification and notification of foster parents involved in a Child Protective Services (CPS) Intake (INT), Investigation (INV), or Family Assessment Response (FAR) stage in CONNECTIONS.

Phase One, which introduced the Intake Checklist Window, was implemented on Friday, 11/4.

Phase Two is tentatively scheduled for implementation in early December, and includes the new Foster Home Identification window as well as the new Foster Care Notification window and Foster Care Notification business function.
