How to Run the CONNECTIONS CBT.

1. Click on the link.
(Click "Yes" if prompted with the message "The Webpage you are viewing is trying to close this window. Do you want to close this window?")
2. The CBT will run.
3. Click the "next" button in the upper right corner until a lesson is complete. You will then need to click on the "lesson tree" on the left to select the next lesson.
4. Click the  in the top right corner of the window to close the CBT. You may need to move or restore down the window to access it.

System Requirements

The CBT was designed for use on CONNECTIONS computers or on any computer with the following system components:

- Intel Pentium 4 (or higher)
- 2.0 GHZ Processor (or higher)
- 256 MG RAM (or higher)
- 40 GB hard drive (or higher)
- 48x max CD ROM (or higher)
- Integrated audio with drivers
- 16 MB video RAM (or higher)

For optimal viewing, please use a monitor with a screen resolution of 1024x768 (or greater).

The necessary software is included in the CONNECTIONS "one image."

Those using their own equipment need to make sure they have the following software:

- Flash player 8.0 or above (Flash is available as a free download at <http://www.adobe.com>)
- Windows media player 8.0 or above

You will need internet access as well as administration privileges.

Troubleshooting Tips

Pop-up Blockers

Active pop-up blockers from Microsoft Internet Explorer and other toolbars (Google) can prevent the CBT from operating. It is necessary to turn off or otherwise manage pop-up blockers.

How can I adjust the volume?

1. Double-click the volume icon in the system tray (looks like a speaker in the bottom right hand corner of the task bar.)
The Volume Control window displays.
2. Drag the PC Speaker Volume slider bar up or down.
3. Close the Volume Control window.
