CLASSROOM TRAINING

FOSTER CARE ONE-DAY TRAINING

Routinely offered in New York City and available upstate by request, this course offers a full day of training in the classroom. Discussion topics include Education, Health Services, and Permanency Hearing Reports in CONNECTIONS. Prior to attending this course, it is highly recommended that all participants attend either the *CONNECTIONS Case Management for Child Welfare Workers* or *Common Core* training.

Certain topics presented in this training will soon be offered in three independent, online courses (see details below), which may be completed in any order. Each course will require separate registration in STARS.
