

Bridges to Health (B2H) Questions
2008 Request for Applications Informational Sessions
Posted June 2, 2008

ALL Forms required in the B2H Request for Applications are posted as fillable documents on the Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) website, EXCEPT for the Application for Enrollment in the NYS Medicaid Program.

Each applicant Health Care Integration Agency and each applicant Waiver Service Provider is responsible for completing and signing their own Qualification Form (OCFS-8034). One Qualification Form (OCFS-8034) for each Health Care Integration Agency and each Waiver Service Provider is sufficient. The Health Care Integration Agency must review, **not complete**, the Qualification Form (OCFS-8034) submitted by each Waiver Service Provider.

Clarifications:

- Part II, page 2: **Application Checklist #4 Required Forms**
Each Health Care Integration Agency and Waiver Service Provider must complete and sign their own Schedule A-Waiver Service Provider Commitment Form (OCFS-8035).

- Waiver Service Providers are **not** required to submit an Organizational Chart as listed in the Application Checklist "Additional Required Attachments". The requirement for the submission of an agency organizational chart, which delineates separation of the provision of Bridges to Health Services, administration of those services and quality management, is for applicant Health Care Integration Agencies.
