Therefore as OCFS is required through regulations to establish the legally -exempt caregiver enrollment services which is identified by OCFS in consultation with the New York City Administration for Children's Services (ACS) and the New York City Human Resources Administration (HRA). A single source procurement was approved for the Women's Housing and Economic Development Corporation (WHEDCo) currently providing the services in the Bronx to expand their services on a city-wide basis effective 7/1/2009.
