

2009-2010 Settlement House – Request for Application Awards

OCFS issued a Request for Application providing Settlement Houses an opportunity to receive funding for a model of service delivery that is both programmatically effective and cost-efficient consistent with the Social Service Law and Temporary Assistance and Needy Family rules. In keeping with the nature of Settlement House, the model proposed by each applicant was to provide comprehensive, coordinated, neighborhood-based and family-focused services. Settlement Houses are recognized as contributors to the provision of these services, and this funding will be used to enhance existing services, including the implementation of greater neighborhood outreach, providing or directing individuals and family members to appropriate community-based resources, monitoring the progress of these individuals, and coordinating intra-agency and community services so that community residents have easy access to a comprehensive range of services.
