A new subdivision (x) is added to Section 352.22 to read as follows:

(x) Restitution payments. Any payments made pursuant to P.L. 100-383 and received by individuals of Japanese ancestry and natives of the Aleutian and Pribilof Islands for the purpose of restitution for wartime relocation and internment will be exempt and disregarded in determining eligibility or degree of need for ADC benefits. Any such payments received by individuals of Japanese ancestry will also be exempt and disregarded in determining eligibility or degree of need for HR benefits.
