The following revisions were made effective as of Q1 2015: (a) Race/Ethnicity is that from Connections (previously from CCRS); (b) new placement category "Foster Adoptive Homes" (a subset of data previously reported as Foster Boarding Homes) has been added to reflect a system change in Connections; and (c) methodology for PINS/JDs In Care calculation has been improved.
