The table below is a listing by System Investigation Request number (SIR) with a description of the issue that, at this time, is scheduled to be fixed with the implementation of Build 18.3.75. This Build is scheduled for the weekend of 7/23/05.

Case Planner/ Case Manager	FASP	When there are two children in a case and one child is placed, Permanency Progress is being required for the child who has no PPG and is not in placement.	The fix will eliminate the requirement for Permanency Progress on a child with no PPG and who is not in placement.	3034
Case Planner/ Case Manager	Plan Amendment	The Case Planner receives an error and is unable to submit the Plan Amendment for approval.	The error generated when attempting to submit a Plan Amendment will be eliminated and the Plan Amendment will be submitted for approval as required.	3127
All	FSS	When doing a Person Search in the FSS the results returned are not listed from highest to lowest degree of matching.	Person Search will return results from highest to lowest degree of matching.	3122
