Build Implemented:

Allegation Incident Date Requirements and Vacancy Control Modernization

On Friday, July 7th, during the normal morning maintenance window, the latest build to the CONNECTIONS application was implemented. Enhancements included incident date requirements for all substantiated allegations in CPS Investigations, as well as the modernization of the Vacancy Control module.

Edits added to the Allegations window of CPS Investigations, which require an incident date and time entered on all substantiated allegations, are in support of *Administrative Directive (ADM) 17-OCFS-ADM-03*, available on the OCFS Intranet Site here: <http://ocfs.state.nyenet/policies/external/>
