Viewing Person History in CONNECTIONS via Implied Role *iLinc Training*

TRAINING LENGTH

30 minutes

REGISTRATION

PURPOSE

The purpose of this course is to familiarize district and voluntary agency workers with what it means to have an implied role in a CONNECTIONS stage, how to determine when they have an implied role, and how to view historical information with such a role.

The course will conclude with a question-and-answer period and participants will be provided with access to a practice simulation available for use anytime.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

As a result of completing this course, participants will be able to:

- ✓ identify indicators on the Person List grid in CONNECTIONS that may point to the existence of historical information.
- ✓ access and view historical information in CONNECTIONS with an implied role.
