Psychiatric Services for Brentwood, Brookwood, and Goshen

Q1	What is the current census or average census over the last year of these facilities? Is census anticipated to increase, decrease, or remain stable?
A1	<p>Current facility census:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Brentwood: 12 • Brookwood: 95 • Goshen: 46 <p>It is anticipated that the census will remain stable or increase for all facilities. We have seen an increase in the population of our secure facilities over the past year. Brookwood is currently operating at full capacity and will likely continue to do so.</p>
Q2	How many psychiatric providers are currently located at each of these facilities and would their terms overlap?
A2	<p>Brentwood: 1 current provider (contract ends 11/30/22) Brookwood: 1 current provider which will overlap (contract ends 6/30/23) Goshen: 1 current provider (vacant, service being provided by replacement coverage)</p>
Q3	If traveling greater than two hours to get to these facilities, would remote work be allowed during inclement weather? Or for any other reason i.e., covid?
A3	<p>Per IFB Section 1.1 Overview, all services are expected to be delivered in-person. The determination to allow for telepsychiatry services will be made at the sole discretion of OCFS during the course of contract service delivery. Decisions regarding remote work will be made by OCFS on an individual basis and will be based on the needs and resources of the facility.</p>
Q4	Would paperwork/charting time be allowed remotely if residents are seen in person?
