Psychiatric Services at Brentwood and Industry Residential Centers

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Q1	<b>Do I have to attach medical malpractice insurance for this procurement with this submission? Or I can obtain it in the future, if I get this contract?</b>
A1	Proof of malpractice insurance may be submitted during contract development, if awarded. The required documents are listed in IFB <b>Section 2.2 Packaging of IFB Response</b> . The first bulleted list in this section of the IFB includes mandatory requirements and states, "All bid proposals must include the following...". The second bulleted list in this section of the IFB states "should also be completed and provided in the bid, otherwise they will be required during the contract development process." Proof of malpractice insurance is in the second list and therefore may be submitted either with the bid, or later, if awarded.
