SUBJECT: Principal Wage Earners and JOBS QC Errors

This memorandum serves to notify local districts that a federal Quality Control (QC) error exists when an ADC-U principal wage earner (PWE), who has been exempted from JOBS participation because of remoteness (Employability Code 26), is not registered with the NYS Job Service. Proof of such registration is a condition of eligibility for the receipt of ADC-U by this class of individuals.

Because of the potential impact upon QC error rates, districts must review the small number of cases in which the PWE has been exempted from JOBS due to remoteness, to ensure that the PWE is registered with the Job Service.

Attached is a report that indicates for each district (except NYC) the number of ADC-U cases in which at least one individual has been assigned Employability Code 26 (exempt from JOBS because of remoteness). Those districts with such cases will receive, under separate cover, a listing of their cases by case name and number.
