This letter is to advise you of the CSE maintenance rates for approved private schools located out-of-state.

These rates are promulgated by other states, recommended by the NYS Education Department, and approved and accepted by this Office.

The published CSE rates for 12-month maintenance rates except where noted. The social services district where the child is a legal resident is responsible for the 10-month CSE maintenance payment, and the local school district placing the child is responsible for the 10-month CSE tuition payment. For CSE summer school placements, the school district placing the child is responsible for both maintenance and tuition payments.

Pursuant to Education Law, the published rates must be paid; they are not negotiable.
