## When Leaving the Program or Classroom

### What to Bring When Leaving the Program or Classroom

Bring an emergency backpack or bag containing the following:

- A First Aid kit (Follow your health care plan when checking and restocking your kit.)
- Attendance sheets and a copy of the OCFS-LDSS-0792, *Day Care Registration*, and emergency contact/blue card information for each child (Update regularly.)
- A charged cell phone for emergency use and a list of emergency numbers
- A supply of tissues, paper towels, wipes, and disposable gloves
- A water jug/bottle (if there is no drinking water source close by)
- Drinking cups
- A trash bag

It is always advisable to have the emergency backpack/bag with you when not in the program or even the classroom, as there is no way of knowing when there may be an emergency or a situation that would prevent reentry into the program or classroom. The backpack/bag should be easily identifiable and kept in a central location that is easy to retrieve when exiting the program or classroom. Know and follow all regulations.
