INTRODUCTION

The need for specialized supports for victims of domestic violence (DV) and their children was officially recognized when New York State enacted the Domestic Violence Prevention Act in 1987. This law (Article 6-A §459 of the New York State Social Services Law) requires social service districts to provide shelter and services to victims of domestic violence and establishes mainstream funding mechanisms for these programs.

As a result of the Domestic Violence Prevention Act, the New York State Office of Children and Family Services' (OCFS) created regulations to:

- Promote standards for the establishment and operation of residential and non-residential domestic violence programs, and
- Establish social services district responsibility for offering and providing domestic violence services and for instituting financial and contractual arrangements with providers of domestic violence residential services.

The Domestic Violence Prevention Act requires an annual report to the Governor and Legislature regarding implementation of the Act. Social services Law § 459-d defines the information to be included in the report, as follows:

1. the number of persons estimated to have been assisted in programs covered by this article;
2. the number of persons estimated to have been denied shelter and/or services;
3. the amount of public and private funds for approved programs by service type;
4. the amount of funds used for the administration and staffing of such programs;
5. the occupancy rate and length of stay by residential program;
6. the name and description of new programs developed by service type;
7. the name and description of programs in danger of closing that received funds and the status of such programs;
8. the name and description of programs that closed during the reporting year and the reason for such closure;
9. the number of individuals who requested and received transitional services and the effect of providing such services to victims of domestic violence and their families;
10. the name and description of programs which received technical assistance and the effect of such assistance;
11. a schedule showing the approved daily rates of reimbursement payable to residential programs for victims of domestic violence pursuant to [section one hundred thirty-one-u](#) of this chapter; and
12. all such other matters as may be necessary to inform the governor and the legislature regarding the implementation and effectiveness of programs covered by this article.

I. 2015 Annual Report Statistical Requirements¹


In response to the data requirements for preparing the Domestic Violence Annual Report, OCFS manages a web-based Domestic Violence Information System (DVIS) which addresses the required reporting elements under the purview of OCFS for both its state and federal annual reports. The system is accessible to all approved domestic violence providers in the state.

The following section of the report is the compilation of data for calendar year 2015 (reported as of March 2016).

Summary of 2015 Domestic Violence Statistics:

- Individual providers across the state received approximately **156,603** domestic violence crisis/hotline calls.²
- A total of **11,585** adults and children received residential domestic violence services.
- Approximately **40,743** adults and children received non-residential domestic violence services.
- A total of **716** adults and children entered transitional housing for victims of domestic violence.
- A total of **12,542** adults and **12,913** children were denied shelter in domestic violence residential programs in 2015.³

² From September 2014 – September 2015, does not include all hotline calls made in the NYC metro area due to separate reporting systems.

³ Denials reported may reflect denials at more than one program as well as victims and their children that ultimately are able to obtain shelter at another program. Therefore the numbers reflect some duplicate counting. This is due to the confidential nature of DV service provision and the limitations that places on data collection.

⁴ Safe Home Network occupancy rates and length of stay data are excluded because the total number of safe homes available varies on a daily basis. Only one Safe Home Network remains open in NYS and is rarely used due to difficulties in locating homes.

⁵ Average length of stay is the mean of all stays in bed nights for each type of residential facility.

⁶ New York City does not have any residential programs that fall under the category of "Domestic Violence Programs."

⁷ Domestic Violence Programs can shelter up to 30 percent non-domestic violence victims. The numbers presented reflect only domestic violence victims sheltered and do not reflect overall occupancy or length of stay for the programs.

⁸ There may be additional transitional programs serving victims of domestic violence not accounted for in this report due to the fact that OCFS does not license transitional housing. Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA) is the agency that license and monitors transitional housing. OCFS collects data only on transitional housing programs operated by OCFS licensed residential domestic violence providers.

II. Funding For Approved Domestic Violence Programs

On an annual basis, OCFS collects financial information from all approved Residential Programs. Financial information is also collected from Non-residential Programs that have associated Residential Programs. Due to the established time frames for the submittal of cost reports, the financial information presented in the annual report is lagged by one year. As a result, the financial data contained in this annual report is reported by domestic violence providers for fiscal periods ending in 2014.

III. Domestic Violence Program Events

Programs Opened/Closed in 2015

- Chenango County Catholic Charities closed its nine-bed safe dwelling program effective 6/30/15 and its non-residential program effective 8/31/15.
- Liberty Resources Inc. opened a non-residential program in Chenango County effective 9/1/15.
- Wyoming County DSS opted to cease providing non-residential DV services directly. They contracted with Planned Parenthood of Western New York's RESTORE program to provide non-residential DV services in Wyoming County.
- Federation Employment and Guidance Services (FEGS) closed its non-residential program 5/5/15.

Programs in Danger of Closing in 2015

There were no programs known to be in danger of closing in 2015.

IV. Additional Initiatives

- OCFS provided technical assistance through a variety of sources to all residential and non-residential domestic violence programs. Through its home and regional offices, OCFS provided on-site monitoring and technical assistance with program and policy development, as well as in licensing, financial and contract issues. OCFS often collaborates with staff from OTDA to assist with reimbursement and local district responsibility issues. Also, OCFS contracted with OPDV to provide training and technical assistance to LDSSs and providers. The technical assistance has improved the quality of services, the documentation of program impacts, and the coordination among stakeholders.
