*Data sources. For Rest of State (ROS) counties outside of NYC, child care assistance payments in the Welfare Reporting and Tracking System (WRTS) database are extracted retrospectively for each service month on a 2 month lag . For NYC cases, NYC provides OCFS with a monthly flat file of all enrollments of child care assistance cases funded with CCDBG for the ACF-801 report. NYC numbers may differ from ultimate number of cases/children with service month claims in a given month because 1) if an enrolled child does not attend in a given month a payment will not be made, or 2) if a child not enrolled as of the end of the service month may later receive a retroactive payment for that month. Other: A small number of families also receive child care assistance through OCFS contracts with CUNY and SUNY schools, but those data are not shown here.

**Case type determination for ROS counties is as follows: "Low Income" includes children with a case type of 20 (MA), 22 (MA - SSI), 24 (Family Health Plus), 31 (Non-PA Food Stamps), 32 (Food Stamps - Mixed Household) or case type 40 and Services Type Suffix R (Low Income Day Care). "TA" includes children with a case type of 11 (Family Assistance), 12 (Safety Net FP Non-Cash), 16 (Safety Net FNPCash), 17 (Safety Net FNP Non-Cash), 19 (EAF), 32 (PA/Non-PA), or 40 and Services Type Suffix S (TA Day Care) or E (EAF). NYC case type determination is based on TA income (yes/no) coding on the ACF-801 report.
