This letter is in response to the amendment request for the following changes to Nassau County's currently approved Child and Family Services Plan 2023 Annual Plan Update (APU):

### Part One: NYS Child Care Block Grant

The district has opted not to provide preliminary eligibility during the eligibility determination period (the application period).

### Part Two: Title XX Child Care

The district has made the following changes:

- The district will use Title XX funds for child care assistance for protective and/or preventive cases only.
- Section VI. Case Closing When Funds are Limited: The district will close cases starting from the longest time receiving services to the shortest time.

The automatic amendments described in *Child and Family Services Plan Annual Plan Update Amendments for Child Care Regulations Effective October 1, 2023*, in addition to the requested amendments listed above, are approved with an effective date of October 1, 2023. The APU is now in compliance with the regulatory changes made by the Office of Children and Family Services.
