This letter is to inform you that the amended child care section found in your Child and Family Services Plan, 2023 Annual Plan Update, was approved and became effective on April 5, 2024. This approval reflects the following change:

Part One: NYS Child Care Block Grant

I. Administration

3: Does your district have a contract or formal agreement with another organization to perform functions using the NYSCCBG?

The organizations with which NYC ACS will be contracting with using private funds are WHEDco, Union Settlement and Bronxworks. Each contract is \$400,688.44 for the current federal fiscal year. Each agency will have the same responsibilities and focus including:

- Outreach
- Parent/family engagement
- Assisting families with the application process for child care assistance
- Eligibility determinations for child care assistance
- Supporting eligible families find care. Collect the completed voucher and associated documentation and submit to NYC ACS for processing.
