This report, prepared pursuant to section 20(5) of the Social Services Law (SSL), concerns: A report made to the New York Statewide Central Register of Child Abuse and Maltreatment (SCR) involving the death of a child.
The death of a child for whom child protective services has an open case.
The death of a child whose care and custody or custody and guardianship has been transferred to an authorized agency.
The death of a child for whom the local department of social services has an open preventive service case.
death of a child. The death of a child for whom child protective services has an open case. The death of a child whose care and custody or custody and guardianship has been transferred to an authorized agency.

The Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) is mandated by section 20 of the SSL to investigate or cause for the investigation of the cause and circumstances surrounding the death, review such investigation, and prepare and issue a fatality report in regard to the categories of deaths noted above involving a child, except where a local or regional fatality review team issues a report, as authorized by law.

Such report must include: the cause of death; the identification of child protective or other services provided or actions taken regard to such child and child's family; any extraordinary or pertinent information concerning the circumstances of the child's death; whether the child or the child's family received assistance, care or services from the social services district prior to the child's death; any action or further investigation undertaken by OCFS or the social services district since the child's death; and as appropriate, recommendations for local or state administrative or policy changes.

This report contains no information that would identify the deceased child, his or her siblings, the parent, parents, or other persons legally responsible for the child, and any members of the deceased child's household.

By statute, this report will be forwarded to the social services district, chief county executive officer, chairperson of the local legislative body of the county where the child died and the social services district that had legal custody of the child, if different. Notice of the issuance of this report will be sent to the Speaker of the Assembly and the Temporary President of the Senate of the State of New York.

This report may <u>only</u> be disclosed to the public by OCFS pursuant to section 20(5) of the SSL. It may be released by OCFS only after OCFS has determined that such disclosure is not contrary to the best interests of the deceased child's siblings or other children in the household.

OCFS' review included an examination of actions taken by individual caseworkers and supervisors within the social services district and agencies under contract with the social services district. The observations and recommendations contained in this report reflect OCFS' assessment and the performance of these agencies.

Presenting Information

The narrative of the 8/30/19 SCR report alleged that at 10:00 PM on 8/29/19, the BM fed the two-month-old SC then placed her on her back in her one-piece pajamas in the playpen with a blanket. At 8:30 AM on 8/30/19, the parents checked the SC and found her on her stomach and unresponsive. The parents then called 911. The report alleged the SC was covered in feces with her clothing soaked with urine, and rigor mortis had set in. The SC had a rectal temperature of 95.5 degrees when she arrived at ER, and she was pronounced dead on arrival. The SC did not have any preexisting medical condition and the cause of her death was unknown. The SC's death was suspicious and the parents were named the subjects of the report.

Executive Summary

On 8/30/19, the SC was found unresponsive in her crib by her BM. The SC did not have any preexisting medical condition that would cause her death. At the time of writing this report, the SC's cause and manner of death were pending.

ACS case documentation indicated at 1:00AM on 8/30/19, the BF fed the SC and placed her to sleep on her back in the pack and play bassinet. At about 8:00AM, the BF was awoken by the BM's screams, telling the BF to call 911. The SC was limp in the BM's arms and there was spittle with blood on the side of the SC's face. The BF called 911 and medical treatment was obtained for the SC. The SC was taken to the hospital by EMS and pronounced deceased on arrival at 9:21AM by the ER Dr.

The case documentation also indicated the BM had 10 children; a 16-yo who had been in the custody of his father in New Jersey since 2016; the 1, 3, 5, 6-yo and the SC, released to the BF through the Family Court on 7/1/19, with COS and temporary OP against the BM. The 7, 11, and 13-yo were also released to their father who resided in Jersey City, and the 9-yo released to his father who lived in Jersey City.

On 8/30/19, ACS initiated the CPS investigation and contacted the ER Dr., the family, and LE. The Dr. reported the SC arrived at the ER with a rectal temperature of 95.5 degrees and rigor mortis had already set in which indicated the SC had been dead for some time. She was covered in feces and her clothing was soaked with urine. There was no trauma to the SC. LE reported no arrests were being made pending the autopsy results. LE deemed the room where the SC passed a crime scene and reported the home was unkempt and had minimal amount of food. The family did not report any underlying medical conditions for the SC prior to her death. Based on ACS' assessment and the information obtained, ACS did an emergency removal of the 4 SS in the home and assessed them at the Field Office. The SS were observed to be unkempt. They had bruises and marks on their bodies. The 6-yo SS disclosed physical discipline by the parents.

Consequently, ACS updated the active Article 10 Petition in Family Court from release to remand. The court granted a remand for the 4 SS. They were placed in non-kinship foster care under the auspices of SCO Family of Services. The parents were granted supervised visits and referred to services.

During the investigation, ACS collaborated with the State of New Jersey Department of Children and Families (NJDCF) for on ongoing assessment of the 4 SS. NJDFC assessed the SS and deemed them safe in the care of their respective fathers. NJDCF provided the SS' fathers with service referrals. Additionally, ACS obtained information from collaterals. The SS were doing well in foster care and receiving services. Supervised visits with the parents and the SS were ongoing without any reported concerns; however, sibling visits with the SS residing outside of New York City had been sporadic.

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The service providers reported the BF was compliant with services, but the BM was not. The autopsy report remained pending.

ACS had not yet determined this report.

LDSS Response

On 8/30/19, ACS contacted the ER Dr., the family, and LE. The ER Dr. reported the SC was declared dead on arrival at the ER at 9:21AM. The Dr. did not report any trauma to the SC. LE informed ACS that no arrests were being made pending the autopsy results. LE deemed the room where the SC passed a crime scene and barred ACS access to the room. LE stated the home was unkempt and had a minimal amount of food.

ACS contacted the NJDCF and requested an assessment of the other SS who were in the care of their respective fathers.

ACS then visited the family. The family did not report any medical conditions for the SC prior to her death. Based on the NY-19-104 FINAL Page 5 of 24



safety concerns surrounding the SC's death, ACS removed the four SS from the parent's care and assessed them for safety. The 1-yo SS had a severe diaper rash and a swollen finger. The 3-yo SS had a swollen finger. The 5-yo SS had a bruise on her upper thigh area. The 6-yo disclosed physical discipline was sometimes used by the parents.

On 9/3/19, the NJDFC reported the 4 SS were all seen and assessed to be safe. The 7 and 13-year-old SS appeared to be taking the SC's death extremely hard. The NJDFC provided referrals to the SS' fathers for services.

On 9/4/19, the BM reported she and the BF were advised by her lawyer not to speak with or attend any meetings with ACS other than visitations with the SS. The BM agreed to participate in services.

On 9/4/19, the family's CP reported that prior to the death of the SC, the BM was not compliant with services. None of the SS were in therapy and the BM refused to sign consents for them to be evaluated for additional services. The BF was compliant with services and cooperative, but he habitually deferred to the BM regarding the SS medical care.

On 9/5/19, the Family Court remanded the 4 SS, they were placed in non-kinship foster care. The court granted the parents supervised visits and referred them for services. The BM stated she was already in a program but did not provide any information about the program.

On 9/9/19, the Family Court ordered the 4 SS to be enrolled in therapy. The court also ordered ACS to explore the MA as a resource for the SS.

On 9/9/19, the ME reported the autopsy results were pending

On 9/11/19, ACS attended the SC's funeral. Also present were the 13, 11 and 7-yo SS. ACS observed positive sibling and family interactions during the funeral.

On 9/23/19, ACS contacted the 13, 11 and 7-yo SS' father and recommended that the 3 SS be enrolled in counseling to address the loss of their sibling.

On 10/4/19, the 3, 5, and 6-yo SS were forensically interviewed at the Child Advocacy Center. They did not disclose any abuse to the SC. Following the interview, ACS provided the FPs with background information on the family to assist the FPs to appropriately address any behavioral concerns by the SS.

On 10/29/19, the 9-yo SS' father did not report any concerns for the SS. The SS had a visit with the BM at the GMA's home and there were no reported concerns.

On 11/13/19, the SCR received additional information with the concerns of PD/AM by the father of the 7, 11, and 13-yo SS, and the PU.

On 11/14/19, the NJDCF did not report any concerns for the 7, 11, and 13-yo SS. The 3 SS and their father denied the reported concerns in the additional information.

On 11/18/19, the MA stated she no longer wanted to be considered a resource for the SS.

Between 12/4/19 and 2/13/2020, ACS made multiple casework contacts with the parents, the service providers, the ME and LE. There was no new information regarding the fatality. The SS were doing well in care. The NJDCF had made several home visits and assessed the SS to be safe with their fathers. NJDCF also confirmed that the SS were enrolled in school. The BF continued to be compliant with services, but the BM was non-compliant. The autopsy report remained pending.

Report Summary:

On 6/24/19, the BM gave birth to the deceased SC. Based on the BM's history of substance abuse and not following through with medical care or clinical health needs for her children, there was a concern for the BM to meet the SC's daily needs. The BM was the sole caretaker for the SC at times due to the BF being at work.

During the investigation, a SUB report was registered alleging the BM and her five adult siblings abuse marijuana and alcohol to the point of impairment while caring for her 10 children. Also, they allegedly sold drugs out of the home.

The BM used and tested positive for prescription drugs during her pregnancy and until 4 days prior to giving birth to the SC. She was unable to provide any medical documentation to support her use of the medication.

Also, ACS observed the home to be in a filthy deplorable condition, posing safety hazards to the children in the home. Additionally, the BM failed to follow up with the children's medical needs. On 6/28/19, ACS conducted an emergency removal of the children from the home; however, the children were returned to the care of their respective fathers with a COS and a TOP stating the BM could not be left alone with the children.

OCFS Review Results:

ACS' investigation was appropriate. ACS merged the 8/9/19 SUB report with the investigation. Based on the information obtained, ACS added and appropriately substantiated the allegation IFCS against the parents.

Basis for Determination:

The 10-year-old child missed several clinical health appointments. The 8-year-old also had severe behavioral concerns that were not being addressed. The children continued record poor school attendance which affected their academic performance. The 5-year-old child was not immunized. ACS went to court to file and order to show cause requesting removal of the children. The court denied the remand for the children and ordered the BM to get the 10-year-old evaluated, all children to be seen by the pediatrician and the family to continue with PPRS.

OCFS Review Results:

ACS restated their position regarding the removal of the children from the parents' care; however, Family Court continued to release the children to BM with supervision.

Basis for Determination:

The newborn tested negative for drugs but the BM admitted she used drugs during the pregnancy and only stopped just before giving birth. The baby remained in the hospital until 4/2/18 because she exhibited signs of drug withdrawal. The BM had failed to secure a pediatrician for the children and the 1-year-old was diagnosed with failure to thrive.

ACS UNSUB the allegation ED/NG. The 8-yo's poor attendance was because the family relocated from the Bronx to Brooklyn. Also, the family encountered issues with the school bus arriving too early and leaving or not showing up at all.

OCFS Review Results:

ACS appropriately filed a Neglect Petition on behalf of the newborn. The BM was ordered to comply with referral and random drug screening but she did not comply. ACS' case documentation reflected FCLS was notified of the BM's non-compliance. The family was under COS with FSU.

During the investigation, ACS observed that the family's home had insufficient amount of food. The parents did not provide any reasonable explanation for the limited amount of food in the home. Additionally, the school staff reported the 9 and 11-year-old children had missed days of school and were not doing well academically. The children were going to school with dirty clothing and foul body odors. The school reached out to the BM but she did not respond.

OCFS Review Results:

ACS conducted the investigation appropriately. The family continued to engage in services with COS.

Basis for Determination:

The BM was non-compliant with obtaining proper medical care and clinical health services for the children. She was also non-compliant with PPRS and failed to provide income information to obtain permanent housing. The BM was non-compliant with court orders to keep necessary appointments for the children. The SF was a PLR for the children as he had caretaking responsibilities for them and resided in the home. He failed to provide income information to obtain permanent housing and had also failed to follow up with necessary medical and clinical health appointments for his 7-mo bio-child.

ACS did not find any credible evidence to substantiate the allegation LSUP.

OCFS Review Results:

The determination of the investigation was appropriate based on the information obtained by ACS.

Basis for Determination:

The BM was aware of the child's clinical health diagnosis and his need for medication management but did not follow through with the child's appointments for therapy and treatment. The BM received notice from the child's school regarding the child's behavior deteriorating. The BM did not follow through with the school's recommendations.

Although the SF was not the child's BF, he resided in the home and had caretaking responsibilities for the child. He was aware of the child's clinical health diagnosis and the child's need for medication management, he did not support the BM to follow through with the child's treatment.

OCFS Review Results:

ACS conducted the investigation appropriately. The family continued to engage in services.

The concerns for this report were IG, and IFCS for the children and the family. The now five-year-old child had hearing issues and needed an auditory evaluation. The parents were given referrals for the child but they failed to follow through with the referral. The case records also reflected the family had an open CPS investigation in New Jersey at the time, regarding the parents not meeting the medical and educational needs of the children.

Basis for Determination:

The BM admitted she had not taken the child for any medical appointments since birth and that the child did not have any immunization follow up. ACS did not observe any formula in the home for the child baby and the parents did not make any viable plan to obtain it. ACS had to purchase milk for the family. The child was diagnosed with failure to thrive. Also, the now three-year-old child did not have his medical checkups and his immunizations were not current. ACS filed a Neglect Petition against the BM in Bronx Family Court. The court released the children to the BM with COS. ACS referred the family to Visiting Nurse Services and intensive PPRs.

OCFS Review Results:

Based on the case documentation, ACS' determination of the report was appropriate. ACS kept the case open for services. The family engaged in services and VNS reported that the child was gaining weight. Additionally, all the children were seen by the pediatrician.
