This report, prepared pursuant to section 20(5) of the Social Services Law (SSL), concerns:

- A report made to the New York Statewide Central Register of Child Abuse and Maltreatment (SCR) involving the death of a child.
- The death of a child for whom child protective services has an open case.
- The death of a child whose care and custody or custody and guardianship has been transferred to an authorized agency.
- The death of a child for whom the local department of social services has an open preventive service case.

The Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) is mandated by section 20 of the SSL to investigate or cause for the investigation of the cause and circumstances surrounding the death, review such investigation, and prepare and issue a fatality report in regard to the categories of deaths noted above involving a child, except where a local or regional fatality review team issues a report, as authorized by law.

Such report must include: the cause of death; the identification of child protective or other services provided or actions taken regard to such child and child’s family; any extraordinary or pertinent information concerning the circumstances of the child’s death; whether the child or the child’s family received assistance, care or services from the social services district prior to the child’s death; any action or further investigation undertaken by OCFS or the social services district since the child’s death; and as appropriate, recommendations for local or state administrative or policy changes.

This report contains no information that would identify the deceased child, his or her siblings, the parent, parents, or other persons legally responsible for the child, and any members of the deceased child’s household.

By statute, this report will be forwarded to the social services district, chief county executive officer, chairperson of the local legislative body of the county where the child died and the social services district that had legal custody of the child, if different. Notice of the issuance of this report will be sent to the Speaker of the Assembly and the Temporary President of the Senate of the State of New York.

This report may **only** be disclosed to the public by OCFS pursuant to section 20(5) of the SSL. **It may be released by OCFS only after OCFS has determined that such disclosure is not contrary to the best interests of the deceased child’s siblings or other children in the household.**

OCFS’ review included an examination of actions taken by individual caseworkers and supervisors within the social services district and agencies under contract with the social services district. The observations and recommendations contained in this report reflect OCFS’ assessment and the performance of these agencies.

## Presenting Information

An SCR report was received on 11/7/18. The report alleged the mother took the one-month-old subject child (SC) to a routine well visit with the pediatrician at 3:00PM. The SC was deemed normal and healthy. After the appointment, the mother fed the SC breast milk. Sometime after, the mother observed the SC to be pale and with decreased mental status. The mother called the father informing him of the SC's condition. The parents decided to take the SC to the emergency room. The parents and the SC arrived at the hospital at 5:00PM. When exiting the car, the SC was in critical condition, cyanotic and agonal. The SC was rushed into the hospital and efforts were made to stabilize and resuscitate him, to no avail. The SC passed away at 6:17PM. There was no explanation for the SC's death making it suspicious. The role of the SS was unknown.

## Executive Summary

This report concerns the death of a one-month-old male child that occurred on 11/07/18. Broome County Department of Social Services (BCDSS) received an SCR report on 11/07/18, regarding the fatality. On 11/07/18 the parents took the SC for a routine well-baby check with the pediatrician. This was a routine exam and the SC was well, with no noted concerns. Later in the day, the mother noted the SC would not eat, was lethargic and she took the SC to the emergency room. The mother called the father and he met her there. Upon arrival at the hospital, the SC was unresponsive. The SC was resuscitated and transported by helicopter to Upstate Medical Center. The SC subsequently passed away and was pronounced dead at 6:17PM.

The ME's autopsy report findings were acute and subacute obstruction of the small intestines, with midgut volvulus and ischemia, secondary to congenital malrotation at the terminal ileum. The death certificate listed the cause of death as acute and subacute bowel obstruction with malrotation of the small bowel at distal ileum. The condition was deemed congenital. There was no evidence of abuse or neglect of the SC. There were no criminal charges pursued in relation to the fatality.

BCDSS assessed the safety of the 2yo SS. The child was observed and interviewed by BCDSS and there were no noted safety concerns for the care of the SS. BCDSS interviewed the parents, family members and collateral contacts who were able to provide information about the safety of the SS. BCDSS requested and reviewed all pertinent medical records of the SC as well as the SS. There were no noted concerns for the care of the SC or the SS. All safety and risk assessments were done correctly and on time. BCDSS completed the required reports timely and accurately.

On 2/27/2018, the allegations for DOA/Fatality and IG against the parents for the SC were unsubstantiated. There was no credible evidence that the death of the SC was caused by anything the parents did or failed to do. The SC died of a medical cause that was not previously diagnosed. The family was referred to bereavement services. There were no other noted safety concerns for the care of the SS. Follow up visits were conducted by BCDSS prior to closing and there were no noted safety concerns for the SS. The case was unfounded and closed.

### LDSS Response

On 11/7/18, BCDSS received the fatality report from the SCR, initiated their investigation within 24 hours and coordinated efforts with LE. BCDSS contacted the source of the report, completed a CPS history check, and notified the ME and DA. The parents were questioned about drug and alcohol misuse, and the parents denied misuse of drugs or alcohol. BCDSS appropriately questioned the parents about safe sleep practices and there were no noted concerns. The 2yo SS was assessed and found to be safe.

On 11/7/18, BCDSS went to the hospital and interviewed the parents. BCDSS interviewed the parents separately and their accounts of the events leading up to the death of the SC were consistent. The parents told BCDSS that the mother had two medical appointments that day, one with the SC's pediatrician and one with the OBGYN. The father accompanied the mother to both appointments. The appointments were routine follow up appointments. Later that same day, the mother said the SC would not eat and seemed lethargic. The mother said she called the father and said she was taking the SC to the emergency room. The father met them outside of the hospital. The parents said when they went into the ER, the nurse noted the condition of the SC and he was seen immediately. The SC was unresponsive, but the hospital staff was able to resuscitate the SC. The SC was sent by helicopter to Upstate Medical Center.

BCDSS assessed the safety of the SS at the home of the paternal grandparents. BCDSS spoke with the paternal grandparents and they had no concerns for the care of the SS or the SC while in the care of their parents.

The BCDSS obtained information from the ME, medical staff and medical records from the hospital, and the SS and the SC's pediatrician. The children's pediatric records noted no concerns for the care of the SS or the SC by the parents. BCDSS spoke with family members and there were no noted concerns for the care of the SS or the SC. BCDSS verified with the parents that they were aware of safe sleep practices. BCDSS offered the parents referrals for bereavement services.
