In December 2015, OCFS ceased admitting newly placed limited secure youth into its care and custody. Therefore, numbers from the 2012-2017 reports for New York City youth in non-secure and voluntary agency settings, and 2016-2017 reports for NYC youth in limited secure settings, are not comparable to those from previous years.
